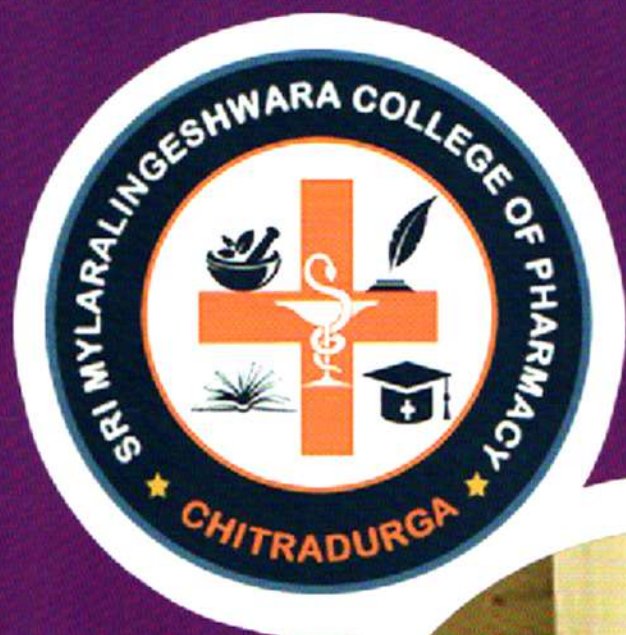

Museum

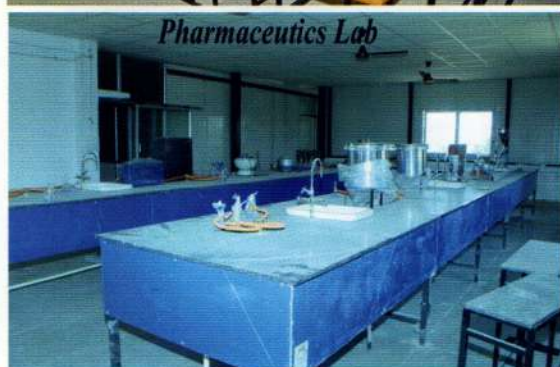
Very well established pharmaceutical museum provided in the college is an informative and visually exciting one which educates the students in many aspects that are not included in the syllabus.

Eligibility for Admission:

Pass in second year P.U.C. (10 + 2 class or any equivalent examination) with P.C.M. or P.C.B. combination

Minimum qualification for admission to Diploma in Pharmacy Part-I course

Minimum qualification for admission to Diploma in Pharmacy Part-I course —A pass in any of the following examinations with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics.

- (1) Intermediate examination in Science;
- (2) The first year of the three year degree course in Science,
- (3) 10+2 examination (academic stream) in Science;
- (4) Pre degree examination;
- (5) Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examination.

Provided that there shall be reservation of seats for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes candidates in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Govt. /State Govts./Union Territory Admns. as the case may be from time to time]

Duration of the course

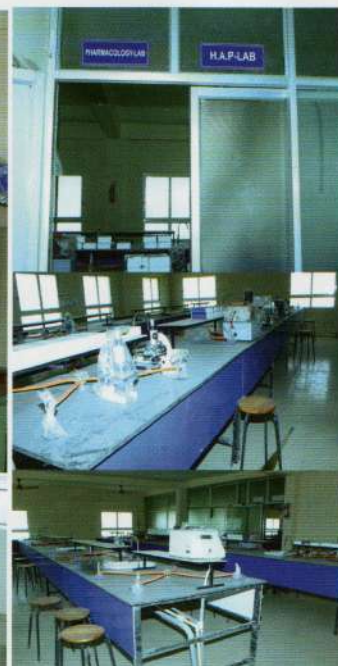
The duration of the course shall be for two academic years with each academic year spread over a period of not less than one hundred and eighty working days in addition to 500 hours practical training spread over a period of not less than 3 months.

Course of study

The course of study for Diploma in Pharmacy Part I and Diploma in Pharmacy Part II shall include the subjects as given in the Tables I & II below. The number of hour devoted to each subject for its teaching in Theory and Practical, shall not be less than that noted against it in columns 2 and 3 of the Tables below.

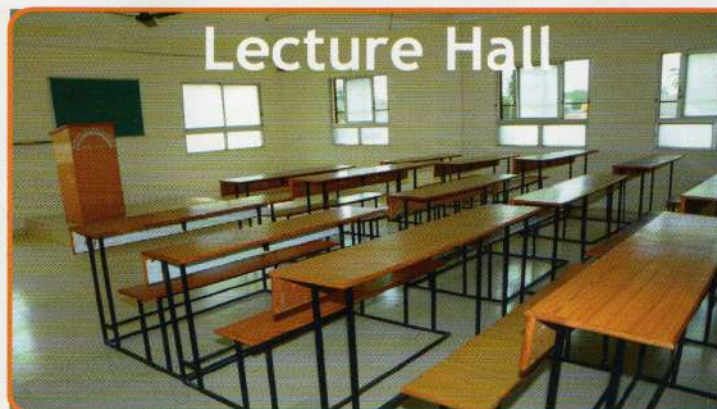

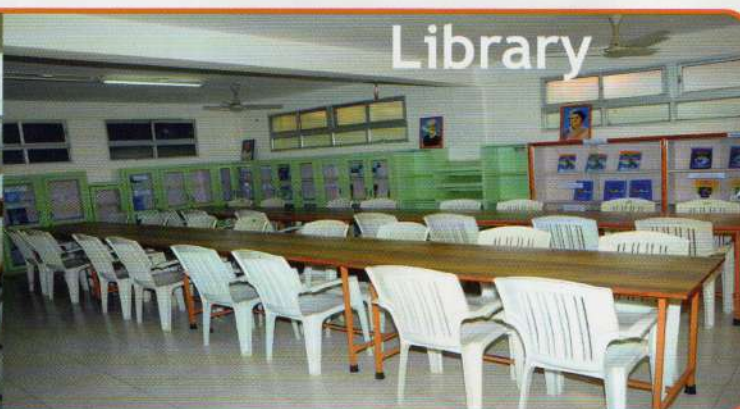

Eligibility for Admission:

Minimum qualification for admission

First year B. Pharm: Candidate shall have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective state/central government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M) and or Biology (P.C.B/P.C.M.B.) as optional subjects individually.

Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

B.Pharm lateral entry (to third semester):

A pass in D. Pharm. course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

Duration of the program The course of study for B.Pharm shall extend over a period of eight semesters (four academic years) and six semesters (three academic years) for lateral entry students.

The curricula and syllabi for the program shall be prescribed from time to time by Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi.



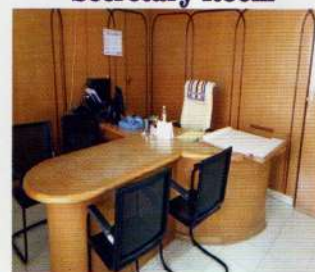
